### 3. International Women's Day & Drug Awareness Program – 21 March 2025, Jointly organized by NSS and CICC

An awareness programme on drug abuse and women empowerment was jointly organized by NSS and CICC under the theme “**For All Women and Girls: Rights, Equality, Empowerment.**” The event featured expert talks, including a session by **Sri G.P. Raviprasad, Regional Deputy Drugs Controller**, who highlighted the health and legal impacts of drug abuse and the importance of safe medicine practices. Dr. S. Basavarajappa, in his presidential address, and other speakers emphasized the role of women's empowerment in building a confident and self-reliant society. In the afternoon, a lively Aerobics and Zumba session by **Sri Sunil Gowda** promoted fitness as a path to mental and physical well-being. The event was presided over by Dr. K. Prabha, anchored by Dr. T.D. Shashikala, and concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. B. Vijaya. The celebration reinforced the importance of health, awareness, and empowerment for women and girls.

The NSS Unit of UBDTCE, Davanagere, celebrated Vanamahotsava–2025 at the R&D Block with great enthusiasm. Dr. T.D. Shashikala, NSS Coordinator, welcomed Chief Guest Mr. Gopya Naik, Deputy Conservator of Forests, Guest of Honour Dr. Ratnakar Obannar, and other

dignitaries. As part of the college's Platinum Jubilee celebrations, she introduced the "One Student, One Tree" initiative, aiming to plant 1,000 saplings with Forest Department support.








## 8. Campus Utility Mapping Submitted – 14 June 2025
